Leading someone to Christ

The following is simply a general guide to help you when talking with someone.

Different contexts: a meeting or other situation

1. Family member. 2. A friend. 3. Someone known to you. 4. First time contact / unknown

Questions to ask yourself?

- Is the Apple ready to pick
- Where are we in the process to salvation
- What has the Holy Spirit done (we want to build on this)
- Has the person been aware (past) of Gods workings in their life
- What is happening in the heart
- Is the person asking the right questions

Questions to ask the person?

John 1 v 38: "What do you want?"

- What do you feel inside. God at work in you
- Do you sense God speaking to you what is He saying
- Are you aware of wrong doing, separation, Gods love for you, something else
- Are you ready to begin following Jesus in Relationship and life-style

Truth to share

- God knocks at the door of our hearts It may be now for you
- God longs to begin a relationship with you. It is why Jesus came and died
- Jesus loves you as you are / knows you (you cannot impress Him).
- Trust in Him, He will come to your aid faith
- Jesus will give you the power and ability as you follow Him
- In the walk, things will start to get sorted out
- A clear decision is necessary from you
- Asking His forgiveness 1 John 1 v 9
- A decision means changing things in our life style & thinking

Now we can pray

- Trust God for a power encounter 1 Cor 2 v 5
- What is the Holy Spirit saying?
- Ask the person to pray out-loud what is in their heart. (talk to Him)
- Lay hands on the person (with permission) invite His presence
- Give general guidance.

A step of faith (responding to Gods heart work)

Go tell someone of your decision. Rom 10 v 8 - 10

- Link with other Christians, join a family
- Begin reading the Gospels, talk to Him

Looking after babies

- Let the person discover Jesus Don't overload with information.
- Help them get rooted. Milk. 1 Peter 2 v 2
- Relationships. Taking care. Important!
